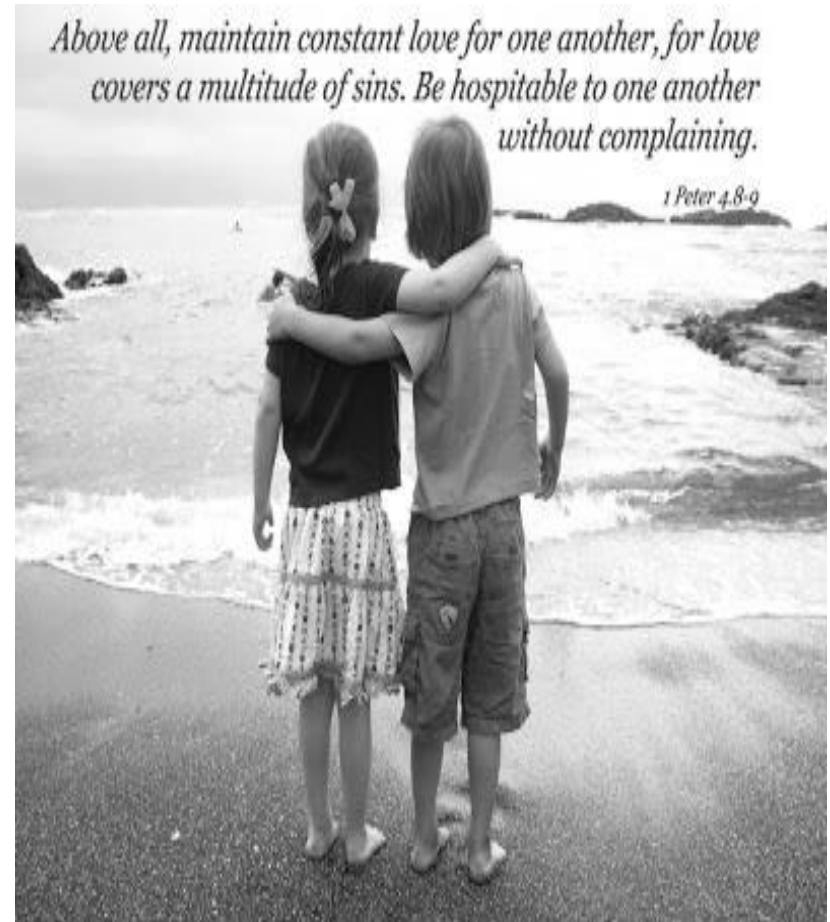
Central Plains: Pray for conference ministers Tim Detweiler, David Boshart and Shana Peachey Boshart.
